Public Transportation

Bay Area Rapid Transportation (BART) to MUNI streetcar:

- From Oakland/East Bay, board a BART train heading for either San Francisco or Daly City.
- From San Francisco Airport or Peninsula, get on any train heading for SF, Concord, Richmond or Fremont.
- Get off BART at Embarcadero station, which is the first stop after BART crosses the bay into San Francisco. Proceed to street level and wait at the MUNI stop on the southeast side of Market Street for the vintage F line streetcar. The fare is \$2.00 and exact change is required. The F line streetcar will go to the Ferry Building and along The Embarcadero. Get off the F line streetcar at the Pier 39 stop. The One Beach building is across the street from Pier 39.

AC Transit, Golden Gate Transit, Caltrain and Ferry Services:

- AC Transit (East Bay) and Golden Gate Transit (Marin) have direct bus service into San Francisco. Caltrain provides train service from the San Jose area. Direct ferry service into San Francisco is also available through Alameda/Oakland Ferry (East Bay), Golden Gate Ferry (Marin) and Baylink Ferry (Vallejo).

Driving Directions

These driving directions lead to the front entrance of the building at One Beach Street. There is no parking in front of the building. Most parking is located within one to three blocks southwest of the building. Parking information is included on the second page of this document. **Please remember to allow additional travel time for parking.**

From **Oakland/East Bay**, use the San Francisco Bay Bridge (US-80 West).

- Once over the bridge, exit at Harrison Street/Embarcadero, which exits off the freeway from the left lane.
- Turn right on Harrison Street, stay on this for a quarter of a mile
- Turn left on Embarcadero, follow the Embarcadero until North Point
- Bear left onto North Point, proceed for one block
- Turn right on Stockton Street, proceed for one block
- Turn right on Beach Street - One Beach will be on the right side of the street

From **Marin/North Bay**, take the Golden Gate Bridge (US-101 South). Continue as US-101 turns into Lombard Street.

- Turn left on to Van Ness Street
- Turn right on North Point, continue on North Point for 9 blocks
- Turn left on Stockton Street, proceed for one block
- Turn right on Beach Street - One Beach will be on the right side of the street

From **San Francisco Airport or Peninsula**, the main freeway is US-101. If you are traveling North on US-280, this will merge with US-101 just south of San Francisco. Take the US-101 North exit toward Bay Bridge/Civic Center. US-101 will bring you into San Francisco.

- Take the Duboce Ave/Mission Street Exit toward the Golden Gate Bridge
- Turn right on US-101 North, which becomes Van Ness Avenue
- Take Van Ness all the way to the end (will end at a parking lot)
- Turn right on North Point, follow North Point for 9 blocks
- Turn left on Stockton Street, proceed for one block
- Turn right on Beach Street - One Beach will be on the right side of the street

Parking Suggestions

Traffic is unpredictable in San Francisco, especially during rush hour. We strongly recommend that you take public transportation or allow plenty of time for traffic and parking. Please remember to allow additional travel time for parking.

Parking Garages

There are many commercial parking lots within walking distance. The following two parking lots are the closest and have the most reasonable rates:

- **Pier & Wharf Parking**, 2300 Stockton Street - daily rate \$10-\$20 weekdays, \$20 weekends. This is an outdoor parking lot and is a part of the Academy of Art College building, just west of our building on the same block. Enter from Stockton or Beach Streets. CASH ONLY!
- **Impark**, 2210 Stockton Street - daily rate \$8 weekday early bird (in by 9:00 am), \$10 weekday regular, \$15 Saturdays, \$10 Sundays. No attendant on duty - self-pay and show receipt in windshield. This is an indoor parking lot located two blocks southwest of our building. This one allows Credit Cards or Cash.

We advise that you avoid parking in the Pier 39 parking lot. This lot can be very costly - up to \$40/day.

Street Parking

- **All-day:** There are a very limited number of all-day street parking spaces in the three-block span of North Point between Powell and Kearny. Check the street signs.
- **Two-hour and Metered:** Along Bay Street and on many other streets in the neighborhood, two-hour and metered parking is available. **We strongly recommend against parking in the two hour parking or metered spots, since leaving the workshop to move your car or feed a meter will be a distraction to the learning environment.**

If you park on the street, please be advised that there are street cleaning and other restrictions on parking. Please read the parking signs carefully!

Handicapped Parking

Those with handicapped plates or placards can park on the street and in metered spaces with no restrictions. The closest metered parking spaces are on Grant Street (just east of the building entrance), between Beach Street and North Point. There is one designated handicapped parking space on North Point at Grant Street.
