

**ASSISTANT OR ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR – CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY.** The APA-accredited Psy.D. Program in Clinical Psychology at Chestnut Hill College has an opening at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor beginning in Fall 2010. Course assignments for this position will be selected from the following, depending on candidate's experience and expertise: psychological assessment; psychopathology; research design; dissertation mentoring; life-span development; biological bases of behavior; cognitive/affective bases of behavior; supervision and consultation; statistics; and/or historical foundations of psychology. This is a 12-month position with a teaching load of two courses for each of three semesters, plus service on dissertation committees and other usual duties associated with a full-time faculty appointment. Candidates must have a Ph.D. or Psy.D. in Clinical, Counseling, or School Psychology, must be licensed or license-eligible in Pennsylvania, must have clinical experience, and must maintain involvement in clinical practice or consultation.
