The Wright State University\* \*Postdoctoral Training Program has openings for Instructors/Fellows, beginning\* \*September 1, 2010. Instructors/Fellows may elect clinical training in one of three practice settings: (1) a domestic violence prevention program which provides assessment and intervention services to adults and adolescents who are perpetrators or victims of domestic violence; (2) adult, child and family clinical training in a community mental health center; (3) comprehensive psychological assessment and intervention services at the School of Professional Psychology General Practice Clinic with a minor rotation possible in the Assessment Clinic.\*\*

Stipends (\$25,000) and health insurance are included in the training package. University affiliation affords full access to library, computer, recreational facilities, internet and State Teachers Retirement System (STRS) /disability package.

Didactic teaching and clinical supervision of graduate students are required of all Fellows. Research opportunities may also be included in the Fellow's training plan. All sites serve diverse cultural populations and the School of Professional Psychology encourages candidates from all backgrounds to apply.

Requirements: Doctoral degree in Clinical or Counseling Psychology, graduation from an APA-accredited program of study, and completion an APA-approved internship.
